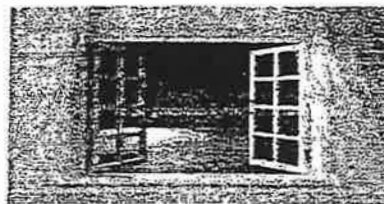

# IDAHO STATE TAX COMMISSION – TAXPAYER SERVICES

### TAX COMMISSION MISSION STATEMENT:

To provide courteous, quality services and to administer the state's tax laws in a fair, timely, and cost effective manner to benefit Idaho and its citizens.

### TAXPAYER SERVICES:

The Taxpayer Services Bureau is the "front line" at the Tax Commission. We answer calls from around the country, respond to e-mail questions that are submitted through our Web site ([www2.state.id.us/tax](http://www2.state.id.us/tax)), and provide service to the public at our counter. Our main duties include:

- Helping taxpayer's understand federal and Idaho tax laws.
- Helping taxpayer's complete Idaho tax forms (we do not complete forms for taxpayers).
- Helping taxpayer's obtain the correct tax permits to start a business.

### CONFIDENTIALITY:

Other than verifying the validity of an account, the Tax Commission can only discuss taxpayer accounts with an account owner or an authorized individual.

- The Tax Commission does provide reports on different tax types that are public information such as sales tax reported for each county and/or industry.
- The Tax Commission cannot give a taxpayer information about what type of entity a business is registered as (i.e., am I a C-Corp or an S-Corp?). Not because of confidentiality, but because we do not have that type of information on file.

### FEDERAL EMPLOYER IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS:

Taxpayers are often referred to the Tax Commission to obtain a "Tax ID Number." A Tax ID number is generally another name for a federal employee identification number (EIN), or in some cases a business owners social security number.

- A sole proprietorship is not required to have an EIN unless he/she has employees. A sole proprietor with no employees may use his/her social security number as a Tax ID number.
- The Tax Commission does not issue federal employer identification numbers.
- An EIN must be obtained through the federal government using a Form SS-4. We do have Form SS-4s at the Tax Commission but we cannot process them.
- Form SS-4 can also be accessed at the IRS Web site, [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov).
- Taxpayers can fax Form SS-4 to the IRS at 1-215-516-3990.
- Taxpayers may also call the IRS at 1-800-829-4933 to be assigned a federal tax number over the phone.

### SALES TAX AND IDAHO INCOME TAX WITHHOLDING ACCOUNTS:

Two of the more common permits issued by the Tax Commission are Seller's Permits (Sales Tax Permits) and Idaho Income Tax Withholding Permits.

- Businesses involved in making retail sales are required to obtain a Seller's Permit.
- Idaho employers are required to obtain an Income Tax Withholding Permit. Non-Idaho employers who are bringing employees into Idaho are required to obtain an Income Tax Withholding account if those employees will receive \$1,000 or more in wages during the calendar year.
- Taxpayers should be advised to call the Tax Commission if they think they may need a Seller's Permit, Travel and Convention Permits, Idaho

Income Tax Withholding Permit, Amusement Device Decals (for arcade games, vending machines, etc.) or other state tax permit.

- Applications for these permits cannot be processed at the Taxpayer Services counter. These forms can be mailed to the Tax Commission or faxed to (208) 334-5364 for processing. Processing time generally takes 2 – 4 weeks.

### TAXABLE BUSINESS ENTITIES:

#### Sole Proprietorship:

- Income is reported to the federal government on a Schedule C or C-EZ and Form 1040.
- Idaho Form 40 should be filed by a full-year Idaho resident.
- A part-year or non-resident should file Idaho Form 43.

#### Partnership:

- The partnership files a Form 1065 with the federal government. Income is flowed from the partnership to the partners using a Schedule K-1.
- Each partner reports income to the federal government, on a Schedule C or C-EZ and Form 1040.
- The partnership will file an Idaho Form 65. Again, income is flowed from the partnership to the partners using Schedule K-1.
- Idaho Form 40 should be filed by a full-year Idaho resident. A part-year or non-resident should file Idaho Form 43.

#### C-Corporation:

- Income is reported to the federal government on a Form 1120.
- Required to file Idaho Form 41 and pay a minimum \$30 tax (\$20 minimum tax plus \$10 permanent building fund).
- ❖ A corporation must file an Idaho income tax return if it is transacting business in Idaho or is registered with the Secretary of State to do business in Idaho.

#### S-Corporation:

- Income is reported to the federal government on a Form 1120S.
- Required to file Idaho Form 41S and pay a minimum \$30 tax (\$20 minimum tax plus \$10 permanent building fund).
- ❖ An S-Corporation must file an Idaho income tax return if it is transacting business in Idaho or is registered with the Secretary of State to do business in Idaho.
- The Tax Commission does not process applications for a C-Corporation to be taxed as an S-Corporation.
- ❖ Entities making this election need to file IRS Form 8832 with the federal government. The form may be downloaded from [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov).

### NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

The Tax Commission does not grant nonprofit status to nonprofit organizations. This status must be obtained from the Internal Revenue Service.

- Organizations may apply for nonprofit status (IRS Code § 501(c)(3)) by submitting IRS Form 1023. They must also obtain a federal tax number by submitting Form SS-4.

- Nonprofit organizations are exempt from business income tax only. These organizations are not required to file an Idaho income tax return unless they receive unrelated business income as defined by the Internal Revenue Code.
- Unless specifically exempted by the Idaho Sales Tax Code, nonprofit organizations must pay sales tax on the purchases they make and collect sales tax on any sales that they make.
